Document	Description	Mandatory / recommended
1. Current resume or CV	It should include all the relevant information on teaching and research experience, as well as on publications and participation in research projects. If you wish to attach other supporting documents, such as other types of publications, certificates of participation in conferences and congresses, specialist course diplomas, professional experience certificates, references, etc., these should be attached to your CV (scanned in a single pdf file).	Mandatory Recommended
2. Copy of PhD Diploma	PhD degree (official copy or photocopy certified by a notary). If the document is issued in a language other than one of the official Consortium languages: English, Spanish or Italian, the candidate must provide an official translation into any of the above.	Mandatory
3. Language certificate for GEMMA University of preference	If the language of instruction at the chosen university is your mother tongue or the language of instruction of your degree, you must add a signed declaration stating this condition.	Mandatory
4. Copy of Passport	Only a copy of the main page (containing photo and personal information)	Mandatory
5. Motivation letter	It should be addressed to the Coordinator of GEMMA, prof. Adelina Sánchez Espinosa, and contain the research and teaching project.	Mandatory
6. Letters of recommendation (min. 2)	Two letters of recommendation from professionals who have worked with you. The contact details of the authors of both letters should be included in the application form.	Mandatory
7. Publications	For each publication, a copy of the table of contents, a copy of the first page of the book/article/chapter, and a copy of the ISBN/ISSN must be provided as proof.	Mandatory
