From August 2018 until June 2021, Prof. Dr Hendrik J. Kockaert was Professor and Director of the Translation and Interpreting Studies Department at Hamad Bin Khalifa University in Doha, Qatar.

In June 2021, he went back to his Alma Mater, KU Leuven, in Antwerp, where he lectures French Linguistics, Terminology, Legal Translation, and Translation Technology. His areas of research are Terminology, Legal Translation and Translation Quality Assurance.

As a certified ECQA (European Certification and Qualification Association) trainer and Job Role Committee Provider, he developed online courses in terminology management. He is a course developer and a training consultant for the PAMCIT (Pan African Masters in Conference Interpretation and Translation) consortium. The PAMCIT project is co-organized by the Directorate-General for Translation and the Directorate-General for Interpretation of the European Commission. He is a member of the work group for curriculum development and course designing in the EMT network.

From 2013 until 2022, he has been the Chairperson of ISO TC 37 SC 1 (Language and terminology - Principles and methods), and develops ISO standards on terminology, translation and interpreting. He is a certified auditor for granting ISO 17100 certification to translation services. He is a member of NBN, the Belgian Standardization Institute. In January 2020, he was nominated as the 1<sup>st</sup> Vice-President of TermNet for a three year term.

He is the Founding Editor of *Digital Translation - International Journal of Translation and Localization*, published by John Benjamins Publishing Company.

He was the coordinator of QUALETRA (JUST/2011/JPEN/AG/2975), and LIT Search (JUST/2013/JPEN/AG/4556), both projects financed by the European Commission.

With Televic, he developed *translationQ*, a CAT tool that delivers an automated evaluation and revision process.
