The Master in Economics provides advanced and applied training that combines academic rigor with a practical orientation, through seminars, and guest speakers from industry and academia. Graduates of the Master in Economics are well-prepared to develop their careers in consulting, research, and professional roles related to Economics, Management, and Econometrics, both in public and private organizations.

Professional Pathways

Students can strengthen their employability not only through the knowledge and skills gained during the programme but also by taking advantage of the **Internships** offered as part of the Master. These placements provide valuable professional experience and direct contact with potential employers.

In addition, students may explore broader opportunities through international platforms and resources such as: **UGR Centre for European Documentation - Jobs, Internships and Scholarships**, **EURES - The European Job Mobility Portal**, and **Jobs and Traineeships in EU Institutions**.

PhD and Research Opportunities

The Master in Economics also provides access to doctoral studies. Graduates may pursue research careers and university teaching in the field of social sciences, including admission to the PhD program in Economics and Business Management of the School of Economics and Business Management (Facultad de Ciencias Económicas y Empresariales) of the University of Granada. **See here information about PhD program**.
