I. Erasmus Mundus Scholarships for Visiting Scholars

Erasmus Mundus scholarships for visiting scholars are destined for scholars to carry out research, teaching or student tutoring at one of the GEMMA Consortium institutions. EMMC scholarships will be awarded to European and Third-Country scholars in accordance with the following criteria:

1. **Third Country scholars enrolled in any third-country Higher Education Institution** can make visits to any of the European partner institutions.
2. **European scholars enrolled in one of the centers that participate in GEMMA** (within any European HEI acting as a full partner of GEMMA) can make visits to any of the **Third-Country partner institutions**.

At the time of filling the form, scholars must indicate 3 preferences among the GEMMA Consortium institutions in which they would like to develop their visit:

- **Third-Country scholars can select** University of Granada (Spain, coordinator), University of Bologna (Italy), Central European University (Budapest, Hungary), University of York (United Kingdom), University of Lodz (Poland), University of Oviedo (Spain) and University of Utrecht (The Netherlands).
- **European scholars enrolled in one of the centers that participate in GEMMA can select:** Universidad de Buenos Aires (Argentina), Universidad Estatal de Campinas en Sao Paulo (Brazil), Universidad de Chile (Chile), Florida International University (USA), Instituto Tecnológico de Santo Domingo (Dominican Republic), Universidad Nacional de Colombia (Colombia), Universidad Nacional Autónoma de México (Mexico), Rutgers University (USA), University of Columbia (USA), University of New York (USA), University of Redlands (USA), Cátedra UNESCO de Cultura y Educación para la paz Universidad Técnica Particular de Loja (Ecuador), Cátedra de la Mujer at Universidad de la Habana, Cuba, the Centre for Women's Studies in Zagreb (Croatia), Goldsmiths University of London (United Kingdom) and the Gender Equality Studies and Training Programme (GEST) at the University of Iceland (Iceland).

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- Scholars should be in possession of a PhD title.
- Scholars should have proven knowledge of the language of instruction of the GEMMA institution chosen for their visit. Proven knowledge of the language of other GEMMA institutions will also be valued.
- Scholars should complete the application form in all its sections, including attached documents, and need to be willing to send any of those documents by post mail if they are required.
- Scholars from outside the European Union need to meet the legal requirements for their visa.

III. Submission of the application

The application form should be submitted on-line via de GEMMA webpage.

Exceptionally, and if this was not possible due to technical difficulties, candidates may email the application form to gemma@ugr.es.

Applications can be completed in English, Italian or Spanish.

A scan copy of the following documents should be attached to the application

(For further instructions, see the section "Inscriptions" on our website: "**List of required documents**")

1. CV
2. Copy of PhD Degree (if necessary, the candidate must provide a translation into any of the GEMMA working languages)
3. Language certificate (of the language of instruction in the chosen GEMMA institution)
4. Motivation letter
5. A photocopy of the candidate's passport
6. Letters of recommendation (min. 2)
7. For the publications considered relevant to the evaluation of the candidate, a copy of the index (in case of a book), a copy of the first page of the book/article/chapter, and a copy of the ISBN must be provided.

Note: If the candidate desire to include other supporting documents, such as publications, certificates of participation in conferences and congresses, specialist course diplomas, professional experience certificates, references, etc., they should be attached to the CV, scanned and gathered together in only one pdf file.

Once the application registered, the system automatically will send a **confirmation email**, which should be kept and used during the selection process.

It is not necessary to send a hard copy of the documents in a first phase of selection process, electronic format will be enough.

After selection, a hard copy of all accompanying documents could be required. Submitted documents will not be returned.
