In continuation to my earlier letter dated 28/11/2015 informing you about two scholarship slots to Spanish nationals, we are pleased to inform you that the Government of India under the aegis of the Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR), is offering **additional five scholarships** to Spanish nationals wishing to study [with the exception of Medicine, Dental, Paramedical (Nursing, Physiotherapy and Anaesthesia courses) and Fashion courses] at graduate, post graduate or research levels in universities and educational institutions in India during the academic year 2016-2017. The scholarships include enrolment and the course fees, besides a fixed amount of living expenses. The scholarships are granted for the full duration of the course. However please note that for science courses, the expenditure on laboratory chemicals and other related incidental charges will be borne by the scholars themselves. Also please note that while sending in nominations of Engineering courses like B.E., B. Tech please ensure that the candidates have taken Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics (PCM) in their school leaving examination.

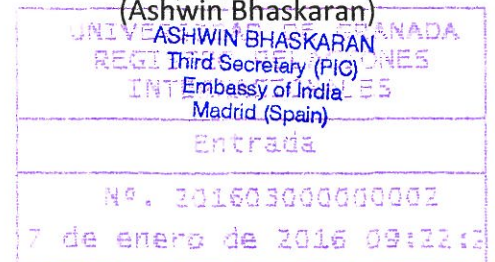

The request must specify the course the candidate wishes to undergo, together with the university / institute of his/her choice in India.
