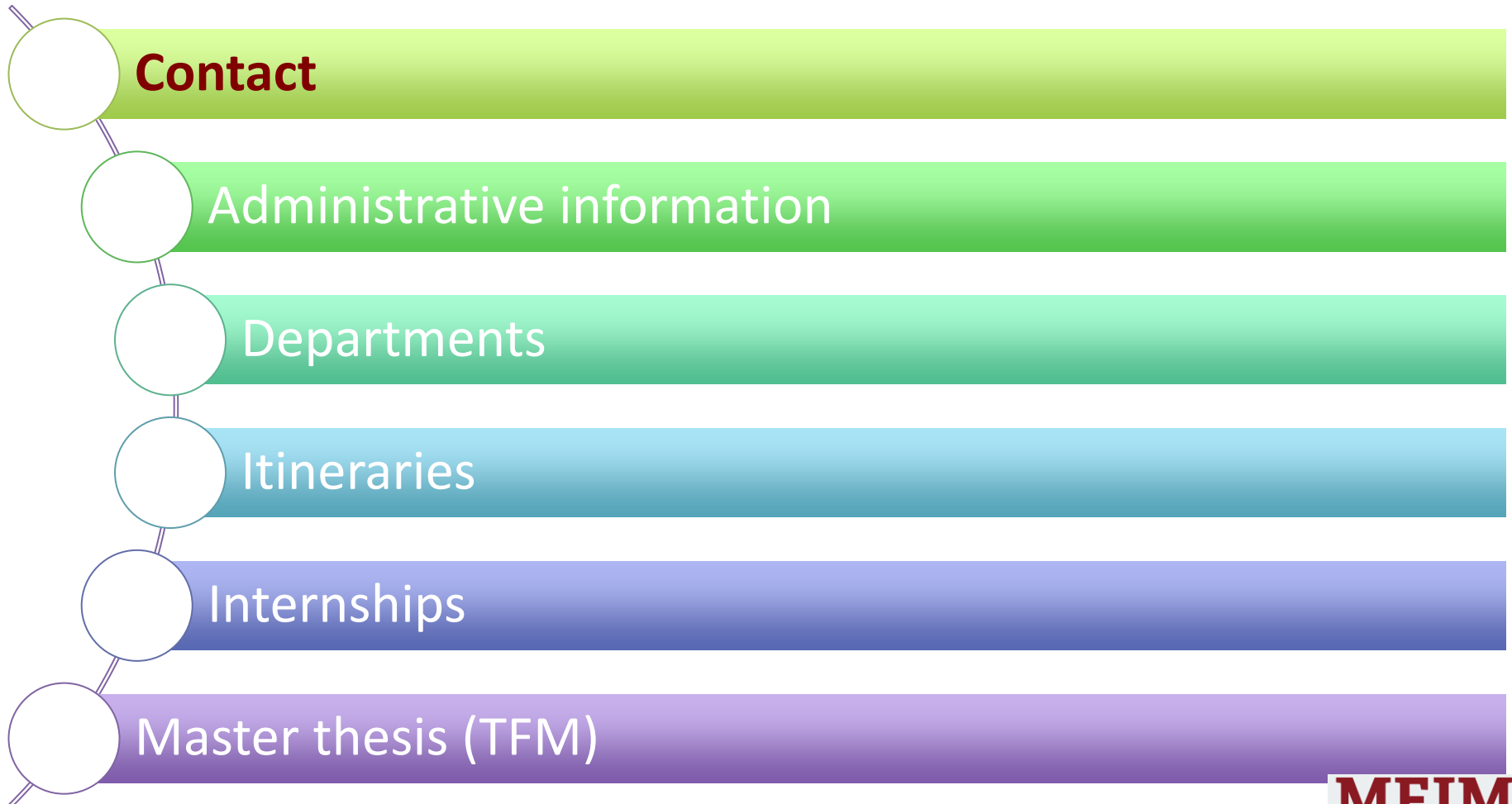

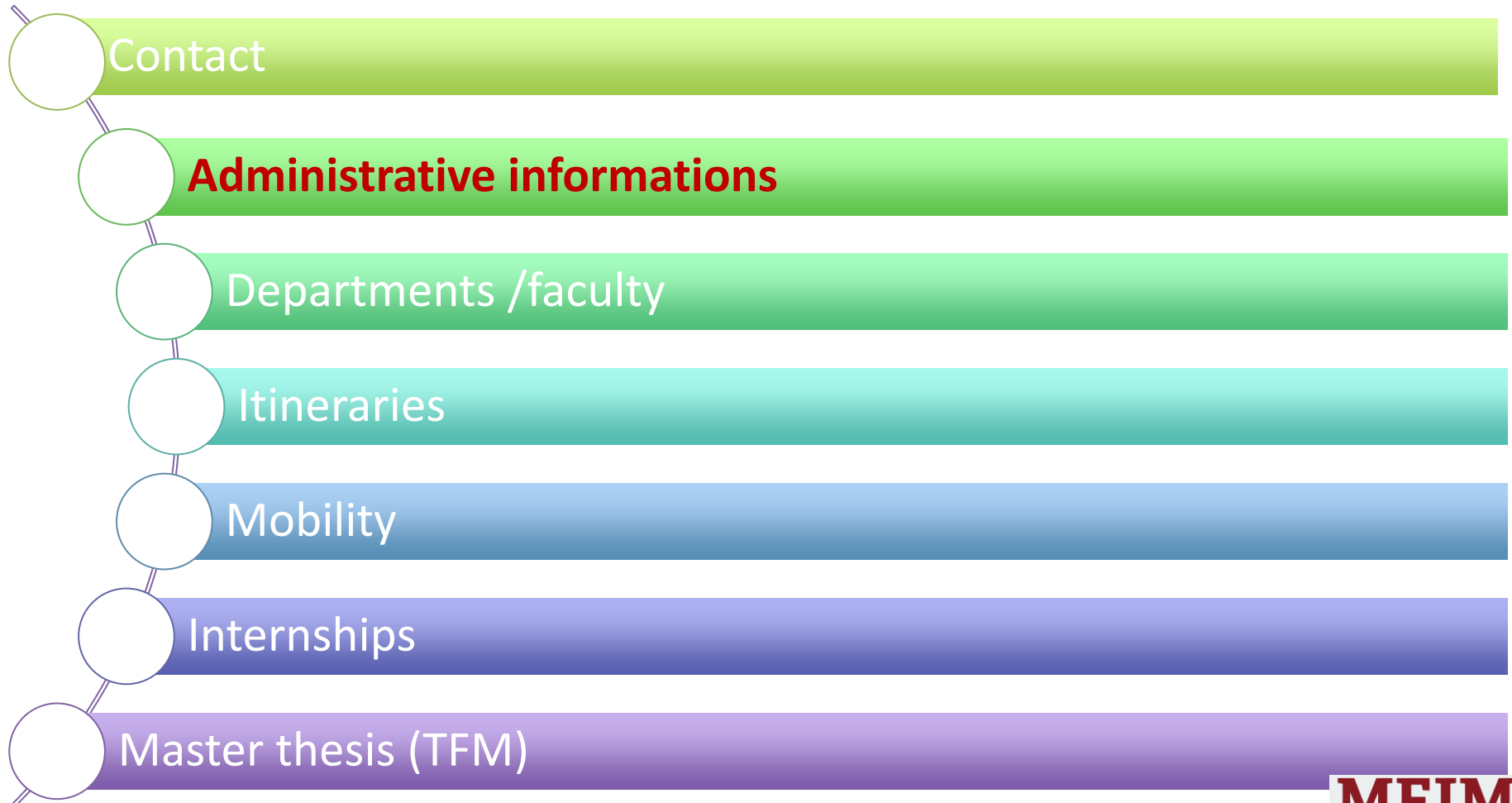

ACADEMIC CALENDAR & IMPORTANT DATES:

- **Classes begin 2019: Monday, October 21**
- **Classes end 2020: Friday, May 22**
- **Examinations:** For courses having both lecture and continuous assesment, the time of the exam will be determined from the time of the first lecture period of the week. For Unique Assessment Evaluation: last day of each course.
- **Classroom: E22 Business Faculty (Computer classroom 3 in some courses).**
- **Last day to withdraw from all courses recovering 100% of all fees: 2019 December 20**
- **Last day to add/drop courses: 2020 February 27 (Very important: if you want to add or drop a course, you cannot have taught more than 20% of the subject, so you have no more that 2 weeks in the beginning of first trimester or second trimester to modify courses from these trimesters, until February 27 (for courses taught in third trimester)).**

Master Thesis (TFM)

The development of the Master Thesis aims to show that the student has acquired competences, knowledge and capacity of application and use of basic tools in Economics and Management. The thesis will be necessarily related to the contents of the Master in Economics. It will be orally presented in order to verify student's presentation skills.

First ordinary call JUNE/JULY 2020

Dates of defense: July, 13th or 14th or 15th.

Second ordinary call SEPTEMBER 2020

Deadline for submitting documentation: September 11th

Dates of defense: September 2020, 24th or 25th.
