Enclosed is the call for the Double Master in Economics (UGR) and Grade of Master (INSEEC). The document is in Spanish. The main points are translated below:

Objective: Mobility of students of the Master's degree in Economics/Economics within the framework of the international double degree programmes with INSEEC (France).

Aimed at: students of the University of Granada who are currently enrolled in the Master's degree in Economics/Economics

Application deadline: from November 18, 2024 to November 24, 2024.

Provisional resolution: December 2, 2024.

Period for allegations: December 15, 2024.

Final decision: January 8, 2025.

Deadline for acceptance or waiver: January 12, 2025..

REQUIREMENTS

- 1) To be enrolled in the Master in Economics/Economics.
- 2) Be up to date with the payment of the fees and public prices for enrollment on the date of the deadline for the submission of applications or have paid one of the installments in the case of payment in the case of payment in installments of the enrollment fee.
- 3) Selection is based on grades, level of English and language of the country.
- 4) Language requirement: B1 certificate in English. B1 in French is also recommended.

APPLICATIONS

Applications must be submitted through the Electronic Headquarters of the University of Granada (sl.ugr.es/0eh4), addressed to the ESCUELA INTERNACIONAL DE POSTGRADO, and in the field "Exposición de hechos", "DTI INTERNATIONAL AREA". The following documents must be enclosed:

- CV
- language certificates
- diploma (bachelor degree)
- transcript of records (bachelor degree).
- Any other documentation accrediting the merits claimed, if not already in the possession of this Administration, in accordance with the provisions of this

SELECTION CRITERIA

Applications will be assessed in accordance with the following general criteria:

- Average mark for access to the master's degree (DUA mark). (We have such information)
- Language proficiency in the language of instruction at the host university higher than the minimum requirement, with the following points being awarded: B2: 1 point; C1: 1.5 points; C2: 2 points
