Course International Economics (3rd Term) - Demography

- ¿For who? Aimed at students of arts administration, business, management, and economics
- At the end of the course, students will be able to:
 - having gained an insight into the basics of demographics, especially:
 - basic definitions of demographics
 - fertility
 - mortality rate and mortality/life – table
 - demographic population forecast: population/age pyramid
 - migration
 - age, period, cohort and the “Lexisdiagram”
 - be aware of the link between the basic challenges of demographics and welfare regimes (esp. pension systems)
 - understand concrete exemplary measures of how state-, semi-public (parastatal) – and private institutions in Germany respond to those demographic challenges
 - recognize consequences for the labor market (comparison Spain vs. Germany)
